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Conductor's Notes for THE GREEN BLUES from composer Christian Overton

“The Green Blues” was written for the 2009 MusicFest Canada All Star Jazz Band under the direction of Denny Christianson. This tune is a really good vehicle for a strong band to show their stuff as soloists and sectional players. It features a sax soli, band soli, improvising for everyone and a nice big shout at the end.

Rehearsal Notes:

- Let your Bari and Bass bone honk out the first 2 bars
- The drummer should play time as indicated when there are no comping slashes
- Bones should play BG's at Bar 15 and at D short and crisp
- Don't let it get too loud at A, there's a long way to go
- Brass shots at C should be big and fat, Saxes in 54 should be a huge section sound
- Have trumpet 4 take the solo break and solo first, after that repeat D as necessary and cue BG's accordingly. Trombones don't have changes but are encouraged to solo (F Blues for them).
- Soli at 75 should be as quiet as possible, with no comping just walking bass and maybe H.H. in the drums
- Make sure low instruments are heard at Bar 89
- Have your drummer let loose with a backbeat from F to the end
- The Band should be going full tilt until Bar 115
- The last note can be exaggeratedly fat
